Only few teachers will believe a student who claims to have understood what he has been taught unless he confirms it through successful writing of a test or examination. Today we will reflect on the things that keep our faith alive or revives a dead one. St. James already gave us a clue in yesterday's reflection; "if a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food" and you just wish him well without palliatives, then you have got it wrong. The faith we profess is only validated when it is practically expressed.

You cannot give what you don't have but there is none of us who doesn't have something to offer. If your hands are capped, your legs are certainly not chained. There is always someone in need to take advantage of and shine the light of Christ. Today's scripture passage is an exposition of the trick to a successful kingdom business. You have been saved to do the work of your savior. It may be good to echo that your work will only make sense if you receive the master of the work in whose name you now do the work.
