# LISTEN TO HIM

*Scriptural Reading: Matt. 17:1-13*

**A**t the mount of transfiguration, Peter attempted to place Jesus at the same level with Moses and Elijah. “If you wish, I will put up three shelters, he said, one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah”. While Peter was still uttering these words, a cloud overshadowed them and God's voice resounded from the cloud; “this is my son, who I love ... listen to him”. God made it clear that Jesus was in a class distinctively superior and far above every other voice. When the disciples heard this, they fell, face down, to the ground terrified. God's voice is speaking to us today to listen to his son Jesus Christ just as it did on the mount of transfiguration. Any structure or project, whether spiritual or material, which is not as programmed by Jesus will not succeed. We must listen to Jesus and not depend only on our own initiatives as Peter did today.
