Scriptural Reading: Matthew Daniel 3: 17-19

e all know about the three Hebrew boys who stood on God's side in Babylon. It sounds interesting as

one reads through the story but very difficult to try. This however, is a typical case of unconditional love of God. It is called an agape love. Jesus told his Father to take away the cup of suffering and death before him but at the same time resigned to his Father's will. It is only agape love that can deal with the tempest of the temptation in this manner.

We have always attached our relationship with God to deliverance from all forms of life's troubles. We need to know that it is not all problems that have apparent solutions.
